
## SCRIPTURE

## Practical Challenge

*Relationships are difficult. It takes strength to submit to one another, to forbear, to forgive... And this strength comes from your relationship with Jesus.*

Ask God what steps you can take this week to focus on and strengthen your relationship with Him. Consider setting aside time to fast, memorize Scripture and/or take a sabbath.



## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS



1. Why do you think the audible voice of God was spoken over Jesus after his baptism?
2. Why do you think it would be wrong for Jesus to make bread? How have you been fed by God's Word? How is it different than just more of what the world offers?
3. Testing God is doing things (particularly taking risks) that God never told you to do. Would this be a new experience for you? How would it make you see decision-making in a different light?
4. Why would Satan's offer to give Him the world have been a difficult temptation for Jesus?
5. How does knowing that you are a child of the King help you with temptations? What can we do to help us move from a theoretical knowledge of being a child of the King to the practical ways we can say "No" to real life situations?
6. How does knowing your mission from God help you to say *No*?
